After the evaluation of the documentation submitted and with recommendation of our technical reviewer the WV Office of Miners Health Safety and Training verified that Mine Site Technologies Pty Ltd.'s "ImPact I.S Communications System" has demonstrated functionality such as would allow WV underground mining permit holders to meet all or part of their requirements for emergency communications and tracking outlined in the West Virginia Legislative Rule governing protective clothing and equipment 56CSR4-8 and will be included in the listing of approved devices.

This transmittal does not negate the necessity of intrinsic safety approval from the U. S. Department of Labor, Mine Safety and Health Administration. Upon submittal of any new or modification applications for such approvals copies of those will be forwarded to this office.

Mine Site Technologies Pty Ltd. shall, upon request, provide this office with verification of valid order, delivery dates, and status of delivery or installation as required to enforce 56CSR4-8. Additionally Mine Site Technologies Pty Ltd will notify this office as soon as it is determined that circumstances have arisen that will impact the delivery, installation or performance of the ImPact I.S Communications System.

Mine Site Technologies Pty Ltd. will provide additional information on the functionality of its approved products in differing mine environments as it becomes available.

Mine Site Technologies Pty Ltd. will ensure that all ImPact I.S Communications System are designed and installed in manner that meet all provision of 56CSR4-8, including but not limited to allowing miner to miner communication in the event that connect to the outside is broken and that pre-programmed messages are appropriate for the mine in which the system is installed.

Any changes required or enhancement made to the ImPact I.S Communications System affecting its ability to meet any provision of 56CSR4-8 shall require approval from this office prior to being placed into operation.
